Dear Governor Schwarzenegger:

We regret to inform you that your employment with the State of California is being terminated, effective immediately upon upcoming Special Ballot Vote. Your termination is the result of extremely poor job performance and providing false information on your application for employment as outlined below:

- *Promises of no new taxes and for decreases in wasteful government spending, as stated during multiple campaign speeches, were broken*
- *During a severe recession you approved the largest single state tax increase in US history, resulting in Californians becoming the highest taxed citizens in the nation*
- *40% increase in government spending and thousands of unnecessary new government jobs since your hire date*

You were issued multiple warnings of your performance problems. Notices of these warnings have generally been discarded, resulting in a lack of improvement in job performance and subsequent failings in management of the Budget. Copies of these warnings are evidenced through multiple mediums. Your acknowledgement of these warnings, as evidenced in rebuttal statements, press conferences and interviews indicate that you have been aware of our concerns. As stated at the March 7, 2009 Tax Revolt in Fullerton, California, you needed to take steps to correct your performance. Your failure to do so has resulted in your imminent termination.

This letter serves as my notice of intent to vote "Yes" on your recall and "No" on Proposition 1A.
